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PEACE Lesson
on February 24, 2025: Romania

Date: February 24, 2025

Location: School educational institutions in Romania

Age: Students of elementary, middle, and high school age

Duration: 45 minutes

Practical Objective: To send written wishes of peace to children in Ukraine and drawings depicting "Peace and Friendship on Our Earth"

Emotional (Empirical) Objective: To provide children with a sense of a positive future in a peaceful and harmonious environment among European nations.

This lesson aims to engage children in a conversation about peace, our shared future in Europe, and what we can do to live in a peaceful environment among other countries and peoples.

The lesson intends to answer the key question: "What can we do together to achieve peace on Earth?"

For middle and high school, we suggest dividing the lesson into four blocks:

Block 1: 5-10 mins

Question (on the board or presentation): *"What kind of facts that indicate why our discussion about peace today, on February 24, is relevant."*

Block 2: 5-10 mins

"Can you name the countries in the world where military conflicts are currently taking place?" (List of ongoing armed conflicts)

Block 3: 5 mins

"What is the main and important thing we should know and remember about military conflict?"

Block 4: 20 mins

"What can we do together to ensure that we and our children live in a peaceful Europe and the world?"

We recommend dividing the class into small groups to explore all possible answers to the questions, and after 10 minutes, one or two representatives from each group can present a two-minute summary of their findings.

Conclusion of the Peace Lesson: 5 mins

Ask children to write wishes for their peers in Ukraine. Collect the wishes and hand them over to the teacher.

For elementary school, we propose conducting a Peace Lesson through drawing peace and friendship with Ukraine and the world.
